



Position in Pediatric Clinical Immunology

The Department of Pediatrics, Faculty of Medicine, Dalhousie University, Halifax, Nova Scotia is seeking a clinician for a hard funded position in the Division of Pediatric Immunology. The Division includes a collaborative team of clinician and basic researchers. It has a national and international reputation for excellence in patient care, teaching and research. The Division provides care for patients with immunodeficiencies, complex autoimmune disorders, and bone marrow transplant follow-up, and includes an advanced diagnostic and investigational laboratory. The Division has Pediatric Clinical Fellows in an accredited Royal College training program in Clinical Immunology and Allergy. There is a strong pre-clinical research program comprising of about 40 research assistants and trainees investigating autoimmune and allergic disorders and immune deficiency diseases. The Division collaborates with other divisions including Pediatric Allergy, Infectious Diseases, Rheumatology, and Hematology and the Department of Microbiology and Immunology in the Faculty of Medicine.

The successful candidate must be certified in Pediatrics and have training or experience in Clinical Immunology. Research experience in immunology or related infectious diseases, rheumatology or allergy would be an advantage. They will contribute to the Pediatric Clinical Immunology service and if desired, may also be involved with the Allergy service or ID or Rheumatology patient care. They will be provided with protected time to develop a research program. They will have the opportunity to contribute to teaching in the Faculties of Medicine and Graduate Studies.

The Department of Pediatrics, consisting of more than 60 faculty members, is situated within the IWK Health Centre, a tertiary care teaching hospital for the Atlantic Provinces of Canada serving a population of nearly two million. It is affiliated with Dalhousie Medical School and located in the vibrant city of Halifax on the beautiful Atlantic coast of Canada.
